The community of Dervaig invite you to come and sample village life whilst staying in their recently upgraded self catering House. The Isle of Mull is one of the more accessible islands of Argyll with a lot to offer the independent traveller, families and groups. There is abundant wild life to watch, walking, a wide variety of wildlife trips both on land and sea, churches, castles, beaches...

The House, a Scottish Tourist Board 3* Hostel, offers comfortable accommodation with the Hall Keeper living nearby. It is a community run facility directly supporting the economy of the village of Dervaig, which is some 7 miles from Tobermory in the north west corner of the island.

Dervaig is an attractive conservation village on the edge of a sheltered sea loch. Pretty whitewashed houses border a quiet main street. There are lovely walks along Loch Cuin, into the forest and to nearby standing stones. A traditional village pub serves good food and has a wide range of whiskies. Calgary Bay, with its sparkling sands and turquoise waters is 5 miles away, and is rated one of the worlds top beaches!

Open Season: We are open all year round.

Bedrooms: 10 beds in 1x6 and 1x4 bed rooms. All bedding is provided. Each room has an en-suite bathroom with WC, shower and wash basin. There is a travel cot available for use, but we ask you to bring your own bedding for it. (Please check with the Hall Keeper before arrival that it is not already in use by another family).

Kitchen: Guests have the choice of using our kitchen facilities or taking meals in the village pub.

Lounge: There is a communal sitting and dining area.

Shopping: Food supplies available from the nearby Post Office and Village Store.
